Airborne Transmission	Spread of virus between users	High	 Social distancing of 2 metres must always be maintained (or 1 metre with risk mitigation i.e. masks where 2 metres is not possible). Only one child is allowed on each piece of equipment at a time. Transmission risk is lower in outdoor settings. 	Low
Further Considerations	Spread of virus between users	High	 Parental supervision highly recommended. Covid-19 Secure signage in place. Users should not visit the play area if they are feeling unwell or have been advised to self-isolate. Councillors should use picking stick and protective gloves when collecting litter. 	Low
