Freedom of Information Procedure

The Freedom of Information Act (FOI) came into force in January 2005, and allows members of the public to request access to information which is not already available to the public.

Access to recorded information can be requested. The Act does not however, cover information that is already in the public domain, or can already be viewed by the public. To view information that is already available, please see the Parish Council's website – www.sanctonparishcouncil.gov.uk

Personal data is not covered by the FOI but is covered by the Data Protection Act 1988. Please see Sancton Parish Council's Data Protection Procedure (available on the website), for how to make a request for personal data.

Sancton Parish Council uses the Information Commissioners Office Freedom of Information Act Model Publication Scheme as guidance.
