#### 210322/6Reports from Ward Councillor(s)

Ward Cllr Rudd updated the Parish Council on activities within East Riding of Yorkshire Council:

- ERYC has raised council tax by 3.99% for 2022/23 financial year. There will be a £150 rebate to band A-D houses, which will be refunded quicker to those that pay by direct debit.
- Surface dressing in Sancton is scheduled for May to June 2022. Pothole patching work has already been completed.
- 'County deal' negotiations ongoing for the devolution agreement between Hull and East Riding. The deal could mean a multi-million-pound investment in the region.
- Homes for Ukraine scheme has launched. East Riding will pay homeowners £300 per month to house refugees. The scheme prefers locations with good transport routes and infrastructure i.e. towns and cities.
- The fourth COVID-19 booster vaccination has been made available to over 75s, those in care homes and the medically vulnerable over 12s. There has been an upsurge in cases in recent weeks.

- b) Cemeteries, closed churchyard and Catholic cemetery the Catholic cemetery continues to be cleared and sprayed. The central path will be reinstated by Lord Manton. One large tree needs removing Cllr Cary will speak with Lord Manton. The paths in the closed churchyard need cutting back and shaping up. It was agreed that Mr Manfield could purchase and place a bench in the cemetery. The total cost of the recent masonry works is £340.00. This will be invoiced in April 2022.

Warcups will look at the issue when they are next in the village.
